	Whiteboard – interactive or ordinary

	Handouts - copies of PowerPoint or overhead projector slides - additional notes
PURPOSE	To give more detailed information
	To maintain the audience's interest
	To focus the audience's attention
	To reinforce and/or illustrate the points you make
BUT NOT TO	Over-complicate the presentation
	Impress the audience with technology
HINTS AND TIPS	Keep slides and handouts simple, with not too much detail in small print – slides must be readable from the back of the room
	Use one slide or handout for each main point of your presentation
	Number overhead projector slides, to make sure you put them up in the right order
	Have enough handouts for all those you expect to attend, with some spares of each one
	On whiteboards and flipcharts, practice writing legibly and large enough
	Carefully proof read visual aids and handouts several times, for spelling, grammar and punctuation
